


If you love pancakes, then Shrove Tuesday is your day! Shrove is the past tense of shrive, which means to gain pardon of sins by confession and repentance. Shrove Tuesday is also known as Pancake Tuesday. It is the feast day before the start of Lent on Ash Wednesday – which falls 47 days before Easter Sunday. In some Christian traditions, Shrove Tuesday marks the last opportunity to use up eggs and fats before embarking on the Lenten fast – and pancakes are the perfect way of using up these ingredients.

Of course, in America, Shrove Tuesday is more popularly known as Mardi Gras, which is "Fat Tuesday" in French. It's the same idea: the last day to eat "fat" before Lent; the last day of indulgence before Ash Wednesday, which marks (pun intended) the first day of Lent. This year our church will be celebrating Shrove Tuesday with a

Pancake Supper on February 21st at 6:30pm and will observe Ash Wednesday with worship on February 22nd at 7pm. All are invited as we usher in the season of Lent!


